Arts Explosion is a week-long arts day camp for students going into the fourth, fifth and sixth grade. Students will work with professional artists and learn a variety of techniques and skills in four of the six artistic disciplines offered during the week.

Arts Explosion will be held Monday through Friday during the week of **July 11-15, 2011 at the Stephens County Fairgrounds**. Sessions will be held between 8:30 a.m. and 12:20 p.m. Students may begin to be dropped off at 8:15 each morning, and should be picked up by 12:30 p.m. There will be **NO** child-care offered before or after the sessions.

There will be an art exhibit of finished projects and a performance presentation, which will be held Friday July 15, beginning at 6:00 p.m. **Enrollment is limited to the first 100 students who register.**

Fees for Arts Explosion include class instruction and art supplies. Registration **before June 30** is \$55.00 per student, and registration **after June 30** is \$65.00 per student. First day (7/11) registration is \$75. The registration fee is non-refundable.

Registration is not considered to be complete until payment is received or scholarship application is submitted with the registration form. A limited number of scholarships are available to eligible students, and applications are available upon request.

So that everyone may benefit from the Arts Explosion experience, discipline problems will be addressed and disruptive students may be sent home with no refund.

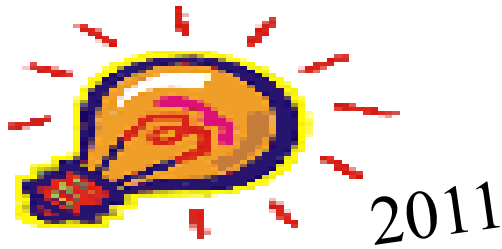

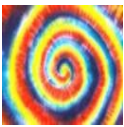

Mono printing — Students will combine printmaking, painting and drawing mediums by using water paints on Plexiglas which is then transfer paper for a unique translucence painting on paper.
